Notes for the captain

- Cleanest game of the round: board 4 (Frempong-Smart Daniel), average centipawn loss 15.4 over 36 moves, no blunders.
- 4 positions swung by more than two pawns across the match; 2 of them on board 1.
- Boards 2 and 3 dropped below a tenth of the starting clock — the training note for tomorrow.
- Across the team the middlegame was the most expensive phase (average loss 35.7 per move).

Average loss is how much each move gave away on average against the best available move, in hundredths of a pawn — lower is better. **Clock low** is the smallest share of the starting time the player had left; * marks below a tenth. A move is only measured when the positions either side of it were both evaluated.
